## Steps for Talent Identification

Step One - Pre-Identification

- 1. Use Haroutounian resources (Sparklers) for art, music, etc.
- 2. Use Leadership resources, Building Everyday Leadership in All Kids, Changing Tomorrow Grades 4-5, Leadership for Teenagers, Leadership for Students

## Step Two - Referral

- 1. Use *Indicators of Potential Talent Scale Observation Rating Scale* by Joanne Haroutounian. Forms are on SLV BOCES website at <u>http://www.slvboces.org/District/Department/3-Gifted-Education/1210-Untitled.html</u> and submit to the district gifted education coordinator.
- 2. Use leadership referral form found on same website.

	• For dance identification, use GRS for students up to middle school.

	GRS-S: creativity, leadership, artistic ability

 Collect information from student/parent/or teacher about performances such as state or national contest in talent area or juried performances the student has participated in (e.g. honor groups, solo and ensemble competitions)

Step Four: Portfolio and Performance Assessment (art, music, dance, drama)

- 1. Portfolio or Audition (electronic or actual) are submitted and assessed by the professional panel using the Ohio Rubrics visual arts, drama/theatre, music and dance include guidelines for trained individuals to ensure consistency
